  - Anaheim Way
  - Anaheim Way and Farragut Avenue
- Install a gate/fence at the 9<sup>th</sup> St Crossing









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

#### **CONSTRAINTS/ROADWAY IMPROVEMENTS**



- Obtaining necessary construction permits from City of Los Angeles
- Intersection curb and gutter modification
- Widening of Farragut Avenue on the east side and Anaheim Way on the north or south side within The Port of Long Beach owned property

#### **CONSTRAINTS/ROADWAY IMPROVEMENTS**



- Street lights relocation
- Sidewalk and curb ramp improvements
- Traffic signal pole replacement and relocation
- Catch basin relocation

A feasibility Study is underway
