




Ecommerce Movement in the NYC Region

New Warehouses in NYC



Ecommerce Activity


- Increasing volume of activity

- Residence as destination





Shared Street Infrastructure

 - Scooters ...?




Safety Conflicts and Lane Obstructions






Enforcement


